American Blind Golf is a national 501 C3 non-profit organization that promotes the game of golf to individuals who are blind or significantly visually impaired. At each sanctioned ABG tournament, the organization partners with local sponsors to support charitable endeavors, particularly those that assist individuals who are dealing with the loss of sight. The official ABG motto is: through the great game of golf, we strive to “Motivate, Inspire & Serve” all those who deal with the loss of sight.

The ABG Tournaments that are held here in Northeast Ohio support 3 major charities:

1. The Adaptive Technology Scholarship Fund that supplies critically needed devices to blind/visually impaired students in Medina & Wayne County. They include: braille note takers, computer screen-readers, computer magnification software and much more...
2. The national research organization, the Foundation Fighting Blindness and
3. Numerous Veteran Initiatives including Wounded Warrior Project and the EOD Warrior Foundation

The 2022 Nations Cup will take place at Pine Valley Golf Club in June (the competitive golf tournament will take place on the 22nd & 23rd). On Friday, June 24th the “Fore” the Warrior Blind Golf Scramble will be held. Area golfers will have the unique opportunity to play 18 holes up close and personal with a blind/visually impaired golfer or one of our honored Wounded Warriors.
